To all our fellow Taekwondo Practitioners,

ACT Taekwondo is pleased to invite all Australian Taekwondo practitioners and their supporters to be a part of the Canberra Cool Climate Classic to be held at Tuggeranong Multi-Use Sporting Facility in Canberra on Saturday 12th and Sunday 13th July 2014.

- Technical and Sparring events will be held at Tuggeranong Multi-Use Sporting Facility in Canberra, ACT.
- Doors open Saturday 2:30 pm for competition to commence at 4:00pm.
- Doors open Sunday 7:30am, for competition to commence at 9:00am.
- Entry for Supporters and General public to the venue will be \$5.00 per person or \$20.00 for a family pass (covers entry for both Saturday and Sunday).

Daedo Scoring

All Competitors Blue Belt and above sparring divisions will use the Daedo Electronic Body Protector System. Our goal is to run the whole competition with the Daedo scoring system. If there are any yellow belts on the day who can borrow or have their own Daedo footgaurds they will also be eligible to compete with the Daedo scoring system.

*Note: All competitors please bring traditional hogu in case of system failure. Any competitors 30kg or below must bring traditional hogus incase daedo scoring hogu does not fit.

Athletes competing in these divisions will need Daedo Sensor Socks to participate.

This competition will be a TAPS event.

Athletes competing in the Open Black Belt divisions for Sparring and Bench Mark Age divisions for Poomsae will be competing for TAPS points.

This event is made possible through the support and partnership of ACT and NSW Taekwondo. ACT Taekwondo has enjoyed a strong history of working with NSW Taekwondo to the benefit of our players, officials, volunteers and spectators. We look forward to continuing to develop a better and stronger Taekwondo community together.

Rules: WTF Competition Rules

No head kicks under 12 years

No head kicks for yellow belts nor cadet colour belts and under.

A head kick in the above divisions will receive the appropriate penalty of Kyong –Go (warning),

Gamjeom (deduction point), or disqualification.

The Head Referee and Tournament Director shall be the final word on contested rulings.

If you have a novice competitor who is in the Junior Divisions or above and a blue belt or above, who requests no head contact, you must contact the tournament director Michael Griffiths directly on 0421 041 161.

Cadet Division

Cadet division for 12-14 year olds. This division includes head kicks for **BLACK BELTS** only. The **Junior** divisions are 15-17 years and **Open** is 18 and above.

For the ACT Cool Climate Classic, **Cadet, Junior, Open** Divisions will use the Daedo electronic system for all divisions.

TAPS: This competition will be a TAPS event. Eligible TA players who win their division will compete for

points as part of the Taekwondo Australia Elite player recognition program. For additional

Equipment: Sparring Competitors must wear WTF approved equipment (or equivalent)

Trunk Protector – Full colour Style only

- Groin Guard Optional for female players
- Shin and Arm Guards
- Head Guard Matching colour or white
- Gloves Compulsory for 14 yrs plus divisions
- Mouth guard All players (must be clear or white only)
- Daedo Electronic Foot Guards for all Blue Belts and above

Uniform: All National and State badges to be displayed on left sleeve.

Coaches: All coaches must have and display current Taekwondo Coach Accreditation to access

competition area.

Please ensure that your club provides sufficient coaches for the players entered as the draw

will not permit delays based on coaches availability.

A maximum of 3 calls will be made, if a player and coach cannot take the court at that time

the player will be disqualified.

Liability: All participants in the competition take part at their own risk. The organiser

can under no circumstances be held responsible for any damage, injuries or

loss to individuals or equipment.

Privacy: Personal details are collected for the sole purpose of the competition. Any health

information collected is for the event only and will not be disclosed to first aid personnel or

any other party.

Draw: The draw will be displayed at the venue on the day of the event.

Uncontested Players: Players who remain uncontested will be advised prior to the event. Players who are

uncontested may elect to receive a medal or a refund. Players wishing to receive a medal are

to present in full uniform when directed.

Refund Policy: Refunds will be paid on application after the event.

Individual Poomsae Competition (1 on 1: Flag Scoring System)

Tournament Rules: Two competitors perform at the same time, on opposite sides of the mat (Blue vs. Red).

Judges will award a winner based on the majority decision at the end of the match; this will be displayed via red/blue flag scoring system. The tournament will be conducted by process of elimination; the winner will progress to the next round. Gold & Silver place will be awarded based on performance in the final round. Bronze will be awarded to semi-final

participants who do not progress into the final round.

Judging criteria: Judging will be based in the order of the following criteria; 1st by Accuracy, 2nd by Power, 3rd

by Expression of 'Ki', & 4th by best artistic impression.



Any combination of ages from 5-29 is permissible. Pairs and Teams in this age range will compete in age divisions according to the OLDEST member.

Any combination of ages 30+ is permissible. Pairs and Teams in this age range will compete in age divisions according to the YOUNGEST member.
