Open - Blue belts & above  
Masters - Blue belts & above

**NO HEAD KICKS for:**  
Minors - All belts  
Cadets - Yellow & Blue belts  
All Ages - Yellow belts



### **\*Warning\***

A head kick in the “No Head Kick” category will receive the appropriate penalty of Gamjeom (deduction point), a second head kick will result in another Gamjeom and disqualification. The Head Referee and Tournament Director shall be the final word on contested rulings.

If you have a novice competitor who is in the Junior Divisions or above and a blue belt or above, who requests no head contact, you must contact the tournament director directly at [admin@acttkd.com.au](mailto:admin@acttkd.com.au) prior to entries closing to ensure competitors all have the chance to be accommodated.
